Water Action Volunteers (WAV) Program



Trempealeau County Department of Land Management staff participate in WAV testing on local streams in Trempealeau County, and we are always looking for more volunteers to expand our areas of monitoring!

What is WAV?

Water Action Volunteers (WAV) is a statewide program for Wisconsin citizens, environmental groups, students, and other volunteer groups who want to learn about and improve the quality of streams and rivers in Wisconsin. WAV participants collect and assess water and air temperature, dissolved oxygen, transparency, stream flow, and biotic index throughout the growing season (May-October) at any stream or river.

Why participate in WAV?

Provide consistent, important data about our local streams. By participating in this program consistently and annually, we are able to document and see changes and trends of the data collected in our streams.
